Purpose

The purpose of this induction pack is to ensure Specimen Hill Primary School staff/volunteers/contractors are familiar with our policies and procedures relating to child safety and understand the important role they play in maintaining and promoting the safety of our students.

Staff/volunteers/contractors must read the suite of policies and procedures in the links below before commencing any work where children are likely to be present.

Key messages

- Specimen Hill Primary School is committed to the safety and wellbeing of all children. We want children attending our school to be safe, happy and respected.
- We are committed to creating inclusive environment where diversity is supported and students feel safe to bring their whole selves to school.
- Allegations and concerns relating to the safety and wellbeing of our school community will be treated very seriously and consistently with our policies and procedures.
- We are committed to preventing child abuse, identifying risks early and removing and reducing these risks.
- Everyone has a role to ensure children are safe if something doesn't feel right, speak up. If you have any concerns about any inappropriate behaviours in the school community you should speak to the Principal, Assistant Principal or Mental Health Wellbeing Leader (MHWL).
