Dear parents and carers,

As you may or may not have heard, all Victorian schools **will not be returning to onsite learning this term** due to the ongoing level of community transmission of COVID-19. The current settings will remain in place until the school holidays which start on Friday the 17th of September.

I would like to congratulate families on the way you are supporting your child/children to continue their education. The response has been fantastic. It is incredibly important that there is some sense of normalcy in children's lives at this time which is proving to be very challenging for the whole or the Victorian community.

ON-SITE ATTENDANCE

Current arrangements will continue. Only children of authorised workers and those deemed to be vulnerable are eligible to attend on-site.

I would remind all families, whose child/children are eligible to attend onsite, that a weekly attendance form must be returned to the school by 4:00pm each Sunday by email or dropped off at the school office by close of business Friday afternoon.

We require this notice of attendance to ensure we have adequate staff to supervise students.

We do not need to see your worker's permit every week.
