BERRY STREET PROFESSIONAL LEARNING

On Friday 20th October our whole staff completed the final module of the Berry Street Education Model which is an approach to trauma-informed teaching. Our staff, who have completed all 4 modules are now recognised as trauma informed teachers. The model combines approaches to welfare, wellbeing, and academic learning to help struggling students develop the skills and relationships that enable them to be ready to learn and be able to self-regulate.

Richard Dougall, Hayden Polgalse and I are attending a master class next week to assist us to plan and lead the implementation of the Berry Street Education model at a whole school level.

The placement of students is a complex process where teachers put great thought into their planning. They discuss, reflect, and review their decisions over a period of times.
