#### **STAFFING UPDATE**

I would like to take the opportunity to inform the school community that Karen Emerson, better known as Mrs E to most students has retired this week. Karen has worked at Speci. for 23 years and in that time has supported many students with additional needs. She will be dearly missed by all. The staff farewelled Karen at a function on Wednesday afternoon and Education Support Staff and myself had lunch with her on Thursday.

We welcomed Belinda Gillie Kemmer to our teaching staff this week. Belinda is replacing Sophie Roberts in Room 11 on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday until then end of the year, while Sophie is on maternity leave.

#### SENTRAL PARENT PORTAL LINK

We are moving to one online parent platform in August. We have made the decision to discontinue our SeeSaw license, this assisted us in through remote learning. The high cost and limited usage by families could not be justified moving forward.
